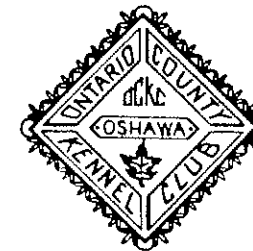

1. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs.
2. No dog will be allowed to compete until Entry Fee has been paid.
3. The Entry Fee must accompany the Entry Form. Please make all remittances payable at par in Oshawa, to Ontario County Kennel Club, and mail to Show Secretary: Mrs. H. F. Porter, 213 Roxborough Ave., Oshawa, Ontario.
CHEQUES MUST INCLUDE EXCHANGE
4. The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry they may deem necessary, subject to Canadian Kennel Club rules.
5. The Building will be open at 8.00 a.m. Dogs must arrive before 12.00 noon to pass through the Veterinarian's hands. All times given are E. D. S. Time.
6. The Ontario County Kennel Club will use diligence for the care and safety of all dogs exhibited but it must be distinctly understood that the management will not be responsible for loss or damage to any dog exhibited whether result of accident or otherwise.
7. All dogs must be supplied with suitable collars and leashes.
8. The Show Superintendent will have full charge the day of the Show.
9. Dogs competing for "Specials Only" must be marked "Specials Only".
10. Dogs that are not entered in one of the regular classes or for "Special Only" will not be allowed in the Show Building.
11. Changing or cancellation of any entry after the closing date will be prohibited. Exhibitors will receive Identification Cards as soon as possible after entries are received. These must be presented at the door upon arrival.
12. Handlers are asked to make alternative arrangements to avoid any hold up in the Judging.

KEN-L PRODUCTS WILL FEED THIS SHOW

The rules of The Canadian Kennel Club, effective January 1, 1961, require payment of a "listing fee" of \$1.00 on the entry of a dog not registered individually in the Club's records at time of entry. There is no limitation on the number of shows or trials at which a dog may be entered as a "listed dog", and the previous requirement that a "listed dog" be registered within 60 days of a show or a trial has been deleted from the Rules. Exhibitors should note, however, that The Canadian Kennel Club does not confer a title on any dog until it is registered individually in the Club's records.

The administration, in any form, of a drug or any substance whose action affects the nervous system by stimulation, sedation, or tranquilization to a dog competing at a show or trial shall be considered as misleading the judge and will be considered as misconduct in the opinion of the Board of Directors. The person or persons responsible will be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the Rules of The Canadian Kennel Club and the dog shall be debarred from the show or trial.

Any person either within or outside the judging ring who does anything calculated to attract or distract or otherwise interfere in any way with the attention or deportment of a dog under judgment, may be disciplined by the Board of Directors of The Canadian Kennel Club in whatever way it considers in the best interests of the Club or the Judge may take summary action. (Chapter 19, Section 18, of CKC Rules.)

Classification

The Prize List and classification contained in this Premium List is approved by the Canadian Kennel Club Inc. N. F. Brown, Secretary-Treasurer.

The following classes are divided by sex and are approved for all Breeds recognized by the Canadian Kennel Club.

1. THE JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS shall be for dogs at least 6 months of age the day of the Show and under 9 months of age that day.
2. THE SENIOR PUPPY CLASS shall be for dogs at least 9 months of age the day of the Show and under 12 months of age that day.
3. THE NOVICE CLASS shall be for dogs who have never won a first prize at a Show in any regular official class. In determining whether a dog is eligible for this class, no award received on or after the official date of the closing of the entries for this show shall be counted.
4. THE CANADIAN BRED CLASS shall be for dogs who are the progeny of a Canadian owned dam at the time of service, CHAMPIONS excluded.
5. THE BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS shall be for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder.
6. THE OPEN CLASS shall be for all dogs. Dogs may be entered for "Specials Only" or for "Exhibition".
